






Thematic online knowledge sharing

- Organic farming and certification (February 2022, 26 participants, 13 women)









ALiSEA Website: End-users need assessment



ALiSEA Website: end-users need assessment

- May to October 2021 = Online questionnaire (194 responses)
- Develop methodology and guidelines

March to June = 20 interviews per country (1 Journalist, 6 Farmers- Farmers organization, 7 NGOs-NPA, 5 Academics, 1 Private sector)

- June 2022




- To discuss and review the Agroecology and Food System Concept and Key Principles.
- To share our common values and to reach common understanding of these concepts and principles.

Results

- 25 participants/ 14 F/ 19 Organizations (Govt, NPA, NGOs)
- Focused on technical aspects of AE and SFS (practices and standards), environmental protection of natural resources and policy support to agriculture.







National Foresight and Theory of Change Workshop – Oct 2022

Objective:

- Connect individuals and organizations with diversity of background, practices, approaches
- Join together for scaling up AE in the Mekong region
- Promote a broad understanding of agroecology concepts and principles
- Strengthen capacity and increase ownership of stakeholders
