## Emerging Context of Extension and Rural Advisory Services

- Extension and rural services remain indispensable; facilitate inclusive rural development
- Small family farms dominate rural landscapes 87% are in Asia; produce 70% of food supply



## Emerging Context of Extension and Rural Advisory Services

- Growing urbanization, changing eating patterns, and agriculture's ability to respond by small farms
- Organic agriculture as an opportunity has proven success but has its share of constraints



Provision of pluralistic, demanddriven and market oriented agriculture in a decentralized system is weak and cannot demonstrate sufficient impact.

Extension is back in the agenda: GFRAS was established in 2010 as a global response



**GFRAS provide advocacy and leadership on** pluralistic and demand-driven rural advisory services for sustainable development (15 regional networks)

APIRAS serves as its regional network and voice of extension and advisory service providers to the international level (MELA, PIRAS, AESA, APEN, CA-RAS)



## **GFRAS and Organic Agriculture**

GFRAS an advocate of sustainable development and support advisory services as partners in this advocacy (vision, mission, guiding principles and Strategic actions)



### APIRAS: Strengthening extension and rural advisory services to support smallholder farmers (capacity development, knowledge management, and policy dialogue thru IFAD grant
