Current Membership Process

Criteria

- 1. Individual meeting between potential member and national secretariat**
- 2. Online Application Form**
- 3. Validation by Gret and National Secretariat**
- 4. Upload Member Profile on ALiSEA website and promote on FB page**

1. Geographical area of work:

- Greater Mekong Sub-region including Cambodia, China, Vietnam, Lao, Thailand and Myanmar.

2. Thematic area of work:

- All levels of experience on sustainable agriculture and/or agroecology.

3. Typology of stakeholder:

- Respect and be aligned with the ALiSEA charter (vision, mission, objectives)

ALiSEA Membership Process

Step 1: Collective Session with Interested Organizations

- ALiSEA National Secretariat will arrange a **collective session meeting** with interested organizations.
- In this session, more candidates express their interest in the organization and detail their reasons for wishing to join the ALiSEA network
- During the session, the ALiSEA National Secretariat will detail the services and responsibilities associated with being a network member

ALiSEA Membership Process

Step 2: Develop Letter of Motivation

- Demonstrate your commitment that details your area of expertise, experiences, motivations, aspirations, and readiness to become part of the network
- Should include your/organization **Charter** outlining vision, mission, and objectives
- Provide **evidence of work** in sustainable agriculture or agroecology (could be in a form of a newspaper article, video, social media post, academic paper, photo of your farm, a record of attendance at a farmers' group meeting, or similar documentation)

ALiSEA Membership Process

Step 3: Submission Your Documents

- Submit your prepared **motivation letter**, either your organization's **Charter** or any available **proof of your work**, and the **registration form** to the ALiSEA National Secretariat

Step 4: Seeking Approval from ALiSEA Board Members & GRET

- ALiSEA National Secretariat will submit all the information and documents that s/he has received from the interested candidates/ organizations to all ALiSEA National Board Members (BMs) to review and seek for approval
- Then, ALiSEA National Secretariat could arrange a meeting with all the ALiSEA National BMs to collect comments/feedback and their decision on the approval

ALiSEA Membership Process

Step 5: Approval from ALiSEA Board Members & Gret

- Approved new members will complete **the online registration form** and **sign the ALiSEA Charter**
- New members will receive a **welcome package**, which contains a **membership certificate** and a **training** in the fundamentals of agroecology.
- In this stage, ALiSEA BMs could request for more clarification/information from any candidates.
- For non-approval applicants, ALiSEA National Secretariat will submit an official regret email to them.
