- ❑ ARMI was founded by 15 former CIDSE staff in October 2006; registration application to LUSEA and approved in October 10th, 2006;
- ❑ Started implementing its first project in 2007 (Self-help community project) in Thapangthong district, with 5 staff;
- ❑ In 2009, the Decree on association was established, and ARMI has received its official registration 511/MoHA in August 9th, 2012.

Target group: villagers in 31 villages.
Period: Oct 2014 - Sep 2017

Main Activities

- **Rice production improvement**
 - model HHs to increase rice yield.
 - Rice field extension.
 - Knowledge sharing among famers.
- **Better livestock management**
 - The workshop for sharing knowledge on animal raising.
 - Animals evolving fund (buffalo, cows, goats).
 - Training on animal health care and animal treatment for Village vets.
- **Gardening**
 - Support village to grow what they eat, eat what they grow. (vegetable, mushroom, rattan, banana).
 - Provided water resources (Boreholes, fishponds).
- **Natural resource management**
 - Support village to established the conservation areas.

- To assess the farmers' perception in practicing of integrated agriculture through a Participatory Monitoring & Evaluation approach.



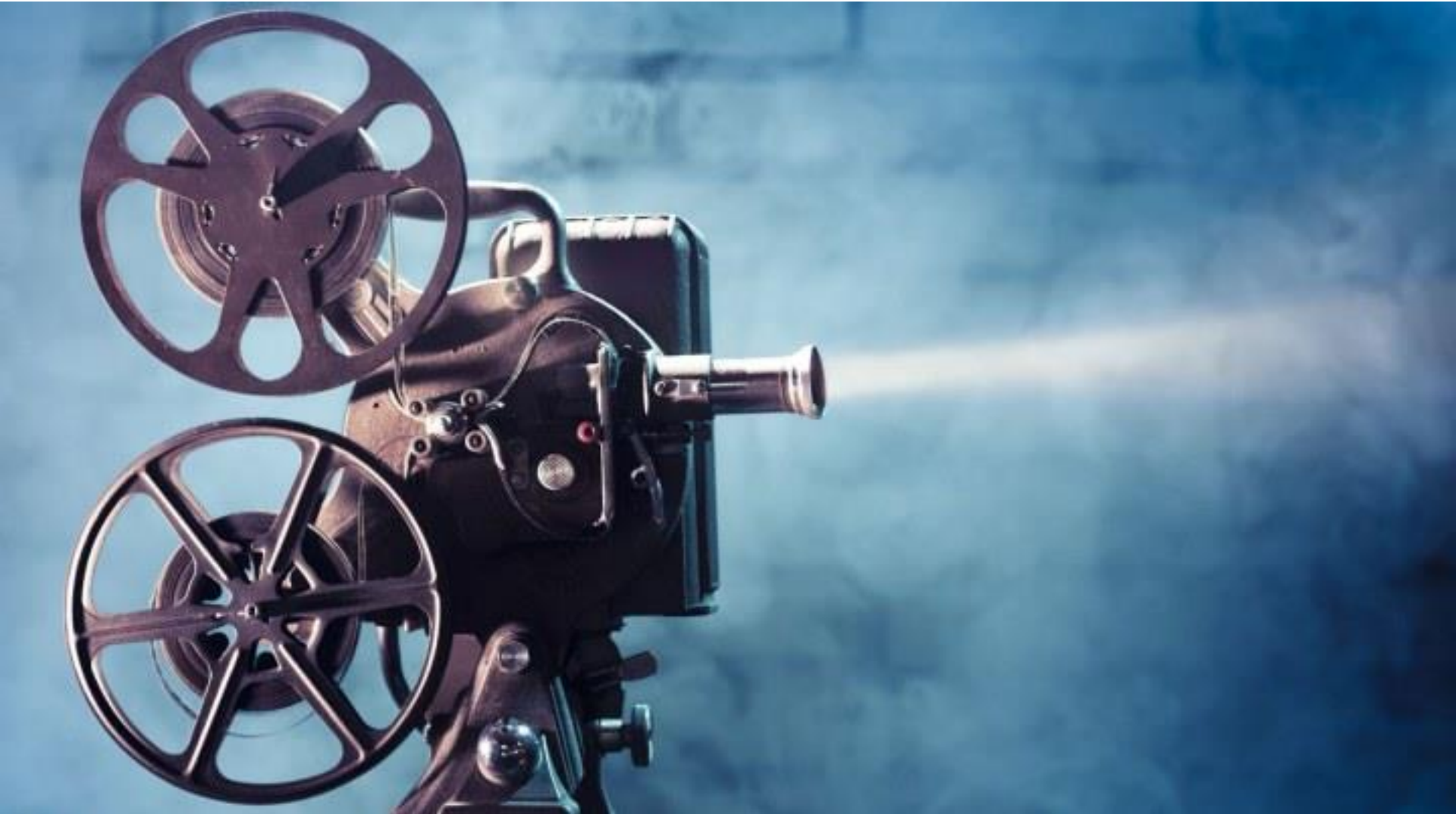
