- Diversify agroecology knowledge exchange and capacity building to ALiSEA members and students by various approaches, such as training, field visit and webinar.
- Well collaborate with existing platforms, CASIC and Farmers Forum, to promote agroecology transitions.
- ALiSEA has been recognized and obtained to be sub-committee member of CASIC, which is a national platform promoting agroecology transitions and policy maker engagement. (August 2024)

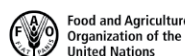
