- GRET has a long term commitment to work in partnership with the government of Laos to contribute its effort to the improvement of the socio-economic development of Lao PDR.



Mediaseeds

Mediaseeds is a non-profit organization involving in bringing visibility and advocacy to sustainability and agroecology.

We are working mostly in **South East Asia** in collaboration with **GRET**, **AliSEA**, **CFI**, **ICCO**, **DCA**.

Along with farmers, federation, NGO staff or extension officers we develop video contents to promote and scale-up sustainable agriculture in rural areas.

We also **develop tools and communication strategies** to foster exchanges amongst farmers and promote their work toward civil society.

We also organized workshops with journalists to sensibilize them and promote sustainable initiatives. In Cambodia, we worked with CFI and Gret to organize 5 workshops to bring journalists to the field and learn about agriculture and biodiversity.

The video done by people trained by Mediaseeds have reached nearly **3 Million views** and have been **followed by 30K people** mostly in Cambodia and Laos.




















• CIRAD works with its partners in the global South, notably in Lao PDR, to generate and pass on new knowledge to support agricultural development and,

Agricultural land conservation and management (Agricultural land titling);



3) Soil improvement: research and dissemination of appropriate technologies and technologies in the use of agricultural land, manage of fertilization and improving the various types of agricultural land to maximize the benefits of local conditions;



ALISEA Network

A learning alliance formed to network all initiatives supporting the agroecology movement, aiming at feeding public policies and support wider dissemination of successful alternative agriculture practices.




